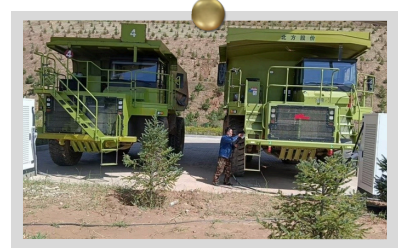

Cherat Cement operates in a dynamic business environment with clearly defined strategic objectives, continuously refining its vision to address modern challenges and ensuring long-term sustainability. Throughout 2025, the Company made significant progress in enhancing efficiency, reducing costs, driving innovation, strengthening HSE practices, and improving excellence in reporting.

As a key step toward improving operational efficiency, CCCL introduced **Electric Dump Trucks** for quarry material transportation in collaboration with its group company, Greaves (Pakistan) Pvt. Ltd. This initiative replaces conventional diesel dumpers with two newly purchased electric vehicles, with plans to scale up based on performance results. This transition demonstrates the Company's commitment to environmental sustainability and operational cost optimization.



The Company also successfully installed a **250-kW solar power system** at the Jubba tubewell, which will generate substantial savings, ensure uninterrupted pump operations during power outages, and reduce reliance on WAPDA. This initiative highlights our dedication to green energy solutions and long-term sustainable practices. Furthermore, the Company has successfully tested **Black Shale** as a raw material in its production process, resulting in a significant reduction in combustion costs. This achievement reflects our constant focus on improving efficiency and optimizing economic operations.



In recognition of its consistent performance and strong governance standards, Cherat Cement Company Limited was ranked among the **Top 25 Companies of Pakistan (2024)** by the **Pakistan Stock Exchange** for the **third consecutive year**. 2025 marked a defining year for Cherat Packaging Limited! It's Flexible Packaging Division, driven by strategic investments, record-setting commercial performance, and deeper customer partnerships, reinforced CPL's position as a forward-looking & innovation-led packaging solutions provider for Pakistan's FMCG and industrial sectors.

A major highlight was CPL's strong presence at **Plasti & Pack 2025**, Pakistan's largest packaging and plastics exhibition, which attracted over 9,000 industry professionals. The platform enabled CPL to showcase its expanding flexible packaging portfolio, launch the SOS Paper Bag business unit, and present high-quality bag formats across food, beverage, household, and industrial applications. The encouraging market response to the SOS line positioned CPL as a reliable partner for professional-grade paper packaging solutions.



In July 2025, CPL's exclusive invitation to the **PepsiCo Supplier Road Show** validated its performance consistency and long-term supplier value. The engagement focused on value engineering and innovation, including material and grammage optimization, ink efficiency through GMG software, white ink reduction without deteriorating print brightness, roto-to-flexo conversions, and digital propositions such as storytelling themes and QR-based interaction. These initiatives were well received by both regional and local PepsiCo teams, reinforcing CPL's role in reducing conversion costs and enhancing shelf impact.

In July 2025, operational capacity expanded further with the installation of a second side-gusset machine, doubling CPL's ability to capture growth across segments, followed by entry into the block-bottom bag segment in November 2025. This investment unlocked new opportunities across premium tea, specialty rice, and detergent categories.

During the year, Cherat Packaging received strong recognition, securing **1st Position** in the **Others Sector** at the **Best Corporate Sustainability Report Awards 2024**, jointly organized by **ICMA International & ICAP**.



Cherat Packaging also received the **Runner-Up Award** in the **Paper & Board Sector** at the **40th Corporate Excellence Awards 2025**, organized by the **Management Association of Pakistan**.

October 2025 marked another milestone with all-time **highest monthly sales of 905 tons**, achieved through strategic customer locking, cross-functional execution, and disciplined pricing.

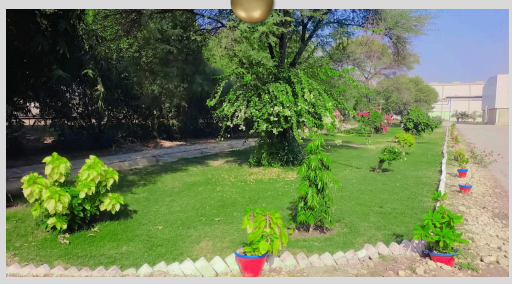


MIRPURKHAS SUGAR MILLS LIMITED

Cultivating Growth with Purpose

Mirpurkhas Sugar Mills continued to build on its strong momentum, advancing operational performance, sustainability efforts, and community-focused initiatives throughout 2025. MSM achieved top recovery ranking in crushing season 2024-25 and secured **1st position in South Sindh**. We increased quality sugar production (pharma & food grade) from 25% to 35% and are aiming for 50% in 2025-26. Our targets for this year include reducing sugar losses, improving cane quality, and achieving a 2% improvement in steam economy.

MSM's Paper & Board Division also set a benchmark with a record production level of **277.129 metric tons per day in 2025**, reinforcing commitment to manufacturing excellence and innovation. Progress on the CTMP plant remains on track for it's integration with the Paper Plant to reduce reliance on imported waste paper. This development enables in-house pulp production and strengthens long-term efficiency.



MSM further advanced its compliance profile by maintaining key certifications including **IMS, cGMP, Halal, and FSC-CoC**, while preparing for the **SMETA-SEDEX audit** to align with global ethical and sustainability standards. The Mills continued championing environmental responsibility through the Green Belt Initiative, under which **1,200 trees** were planted across the site.

In recognition of its commitment to transparency and reporting excellence, MSM received **2nd position** in the **Sugar Sector** at the **Best Corporate Sustainability Report Awards 2024**, jointly organized by **ICMA International & ICAP**.



Building on this commitment, MSM delivered several employee and community programmes, including an **Emergency Response Training with Rescue 1122**, in-house sessions on **Human Rights and Ethical Trade Policies**, and healthcare camps that supported **eye-screenings** and **dental checkups** of employees.



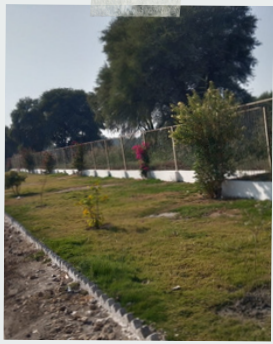
Further extending its community outreach, MSM organized the **Ramzan Bachat Bazar** across three locations, distributing 15MT of essential commodities to **15,000 beneficiaries**.

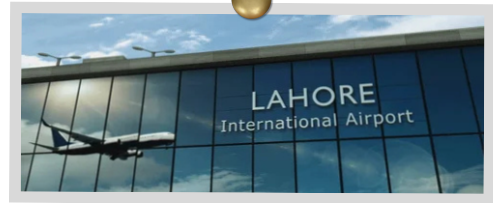

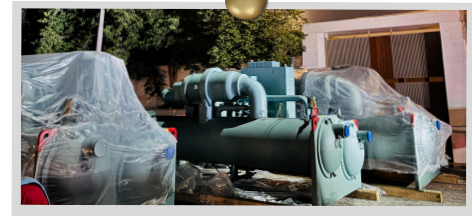
In 2025, Greaves Airconditioning delivered a year of disciplined execution and strategic momentum, anchored in people development and major infrastructure engagement. The focus remained on strengthening organizational capability, deepening technical readiness, and expanding the Company’s footprint across complex, high-specification projects.

Greaves Airconditioning Private Limited was awarded a work order for centrifugal chillers totaling 1,800 tons for the expansion of the Terminal Building and Allied Facilities at **Allama Iqbal International Airport, Lahore**.



Moreover, the Company secured a work order for the supply and installation of HVAC systems for Sindh’s first **Cultural Heritage & Architecture University, Aror University**, based on air-cooled inverter YORK VRF technology with 164 tons of cooling capacity.

Greaves Airconditioning also successfully delivered 900 tons of chillers, Air Handling Units, Fresh Air Handling Units, Fan Coil Units, Cooling Towers, and VFDs for **HBL Tower-2, Clifton, Karachi**.



In a significant strategic development, Greaves Airconditioning entered into a **partnership with Schneider Electric Pakistan**, marking the start of a collaboration focused on delivering large-scale, future-ready projects. This alliance brings together innovation, integration expertise, and a shared vision for digital transformation, enabling sustainable growth and operational excellence for customers across industries.

In parallel, Greaves Airconditioning arranged a **training session** for employees on **“financial independence”** to enhance our people’s money management skills and decision-making.

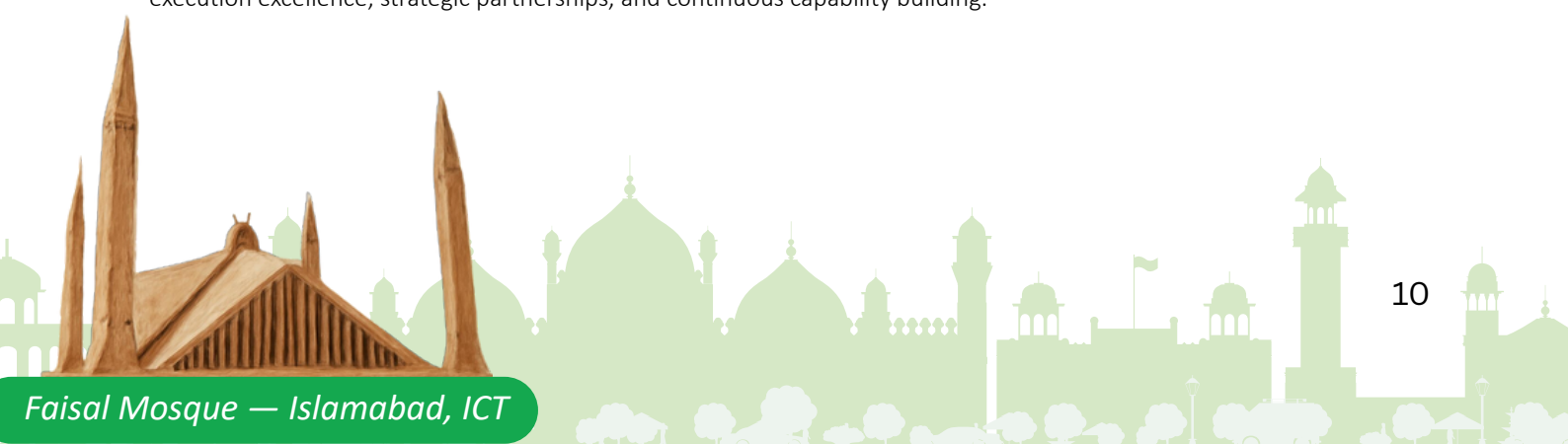

Additional training sessions conducted by **Johnson Controls LLC** on YZ Magnetic Bearing Chillers provided in-depth knowledge on advanced controls and oil-free technology operations.

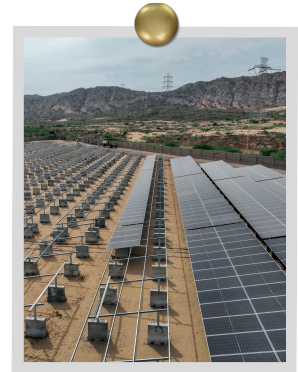

Engineering Solutions Powering Pakistan

In 2025, Greaves Pakistan gained strong momentum across its diversified portfolio, reinforcing its position as a trusted provider of integrated energy, infrastructure, and industrial solutions. The year marked solid progress and growth across power generation, elevators and escalators, mining, automation, and after-sales services.

Under Greaves Solar, the Company strengthened its BESS portfolio and expanded its commercial and industrial presence, highlighted by a 9 MW extension at Cherat Cement, building on an existing 13.5 MW system. Key deployments included Feroze1888 – 5 MW, Master Beverages & Foods – 1,000 KW, YKK – 1.2 MW, Star Laboratories Phase 2 – 717 KW, Ghani ChemWorld – 380 KW, FMC United – 150 KW, FTC – 360 KW, Adamjee Pharma – 250 KW, and Al Hamd International Container Terminal – 250 KW.



The residential segment launched an exclusive solar financing solution with Faysal Bank for Roshan Digital Account customers. It delivered a landmark 600 kW multi-site project at Karachi Grammar School, featuring **Pakistan's first advanced solar carport structure**.

The **Generators Division** delivered a 7.2 MW turnkey Rehlko diesel generator solution for Emaar's The Views Tower and supplied DG sets of various ratings to Bank Al Habib, Faysal Bank, Venturetronics Pvt. Ltd. (250 kVA), and DIC Pakistan Pvt. Ltd. (100 kVA).



The **Earth Moving Equipment Division** expanded its portfolio with **Metso, Hitachi, and NHL** as authorized principals. Further, it delivered **Pakistan's first Battery Electric Dump Trucks (NHL TR50E)** to Cherat Cement, marking a milestone in electric mobility for mining.

The **Vertical Transportation Division** installed OTIS elevators and escalators across landmark projects, including the FTC, ABL Tower Lahore, Allied Bank Head Office, Center Point Building, and Emaar developments in Karachi.

The **Petroleum & Refueling Division** delivered VFD installations for leading pharmaceutical, textile, and energy clients—AGP Pharma, PARCO Gunvor, Artistic Milliners, and Siddiq Sons (Pvt.) Ltd.—while advancing fuel station automation through end-to-end ATG and automation system deployments for Wafi Energy (formerly Shell Pakistan), Attock Petroleum, GO Aramco, Cnergyico, PARCO Gunvor, and Caltex Pakistan (BE Energy). During the quarter, the division recorded an 18% higher performance compared to the corresponding period of the previous year and also entered the **EV charger solutions space**, supporting Pakistan's shift toward sustainable mobility.



The **Industrial Division** delivered exceptional performance, achieving a 42% increase during the quarter compared to the same period last year. Key highlights included the supply, installation, and commissioning of large high-viscosity industrial gear pumps and Pakistan's first high-speed bottom agitator/mixers at the Hi-Tech Blending Plant in Lahore, reinforcing Greaves' leadership in engineered fluid-handling solutions.

The **Emerson Automation Division** delivered Pakistan's first fully equipped Edible Oil Terminal for Apical Pakistan, featuring Rosemount Wireless Tank Gauging across 26 tanks. During the period, the division recorded a 341% higher performance compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, and cemented Greaves Pakistan's leadership in advanced automation and remote monitoring.

The Company also secured a repeat order for its **Emulation-based Inventory & Fuel Management System**, extending deployment to 12 additional tanks at the client's Kemari Terminal following a successful 33-tank implementation at a Karachi refinery—underscoring strong confidence in the system's reliability and precision.



The **Water Division** delivered critical pumping installations for Emaar Panorama and The Views, Soorty Enterprises, IBA, and Security Paper Mills.

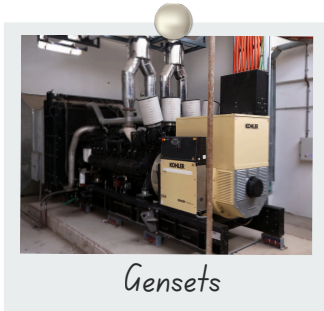
The **UPS Division** expanded its footprint with solutions up to 200 kVA for Unilever Pakistan, DHA Dolmen Lahore, Nawaz Sharif Institute of Cardiology (NSIC) Sargodha, Gourmet Foods Lahore, SM Foods Multan, Sheikho Sugar Mill, Meezan Bank, and Getz Pharma.

The **Rental Division** continued scaling MW-class power deployments of 4 x 1250 KVA Brand-New Diesel Genset on a rental basis in North region.

Beyond regular Annual Maintenance Contracts for the UPS and Genset divisions, over 40 operational staff are deployed to manage the operation and maintenance of 31 gensets at the State Bank of Pakistan (South Region). The **Service Division** also expanded its UPS AMC customer base, onboarding key clients including Ufone – Baykee UPS Solutions, K-Electric, Indus Hospital, Aisha Steel Mills, Khushhali Bank, Citi Bank (CBRE), and EFU Insurance, reflecting growing market confidence in GPPL's long-term service capabilities.

Together, these achievements underscore Greaves Pakistan's disciplined execution, engineering depth, and expanding role in Pakistan's evolving energy and industrial landscape!

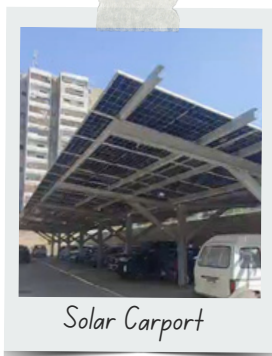

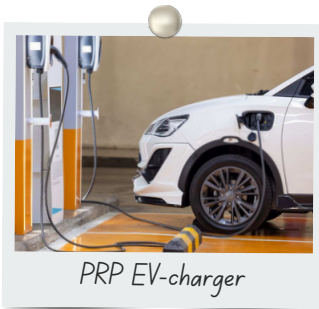

Unicol Limited delivered a year of strong operational performance, safety leadership, and sustainability-focused progress. A major milestone was achieved with the largest single delivery of bulk ethanol ever recorded, totaling 8,800 metric tons, reflecting sustained customer confidence in Unicol’s products and services and reinforcing its position as a leading player in the industry.

Operating within an agriculture-based ecosystem, Unicol continued to prioritize environmental stewardship through **targeted R&D initiatives**, including the application of distillery spent wash to soil. Leveraging its high organic content, this initiative is expected to enhance soil fertility while contributing positively to broader environmental outcomes.

Unicol further strengthened its commitment to continuous improvement by upgrading its **HSE-compliant diesel dispensing system**, enhancing operational efficiency while ensuring employee safety and environmental protection.

Another significant achievement was the successful construction and commissioning of a **new ethanol storage tank** with an additional capacity of **4,000,000 litres**, equipped with advanced firefighting systems such as foam pourers, sprinklers, and deluge systems. The project was completed with a flawless safety record, recording zero accidents, injuries, or LTIs, underscoring strong teamwork and disciplined execution.



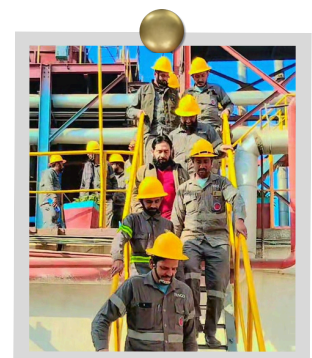

Unicol also advanced its talent pipeline through a **recruitment drive** at the **University of Sargodha**, resulting in the successful onboarding of a qualified professional for the Cane Department.

Additionally, UNICOL Sugar Mill hosted a group of experienced **WAPDA employees** undergoing training at the **CTC FESCO Training Center**, who were given a detailed overview of the mill’s electrical systems, safety protocols, and standard practices in power generation, transmission, and distribution. The visit enabled productive knowledge sharing and reinforced professional collaboration.



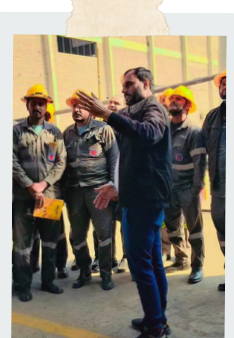

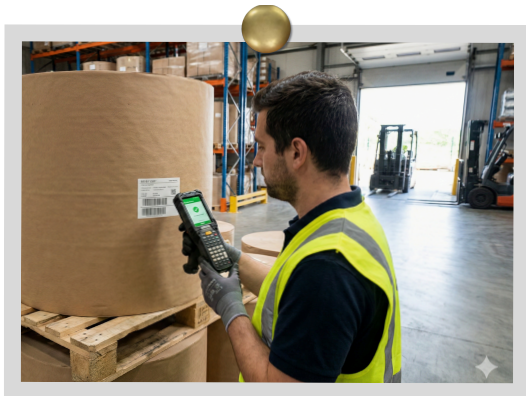

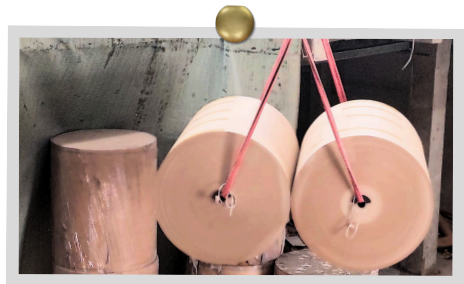
These initiatives were designed to translate technology investments into tangible, on-ground business impact across core operations.

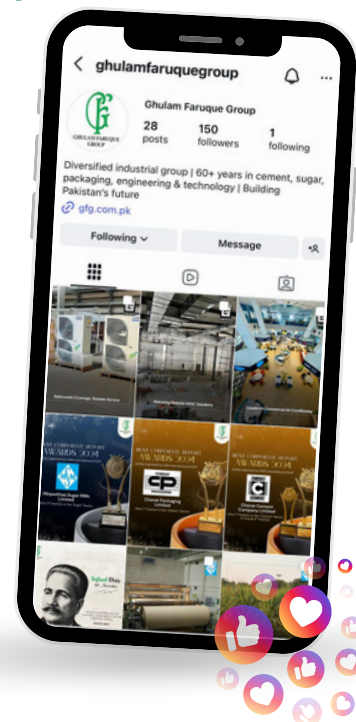
