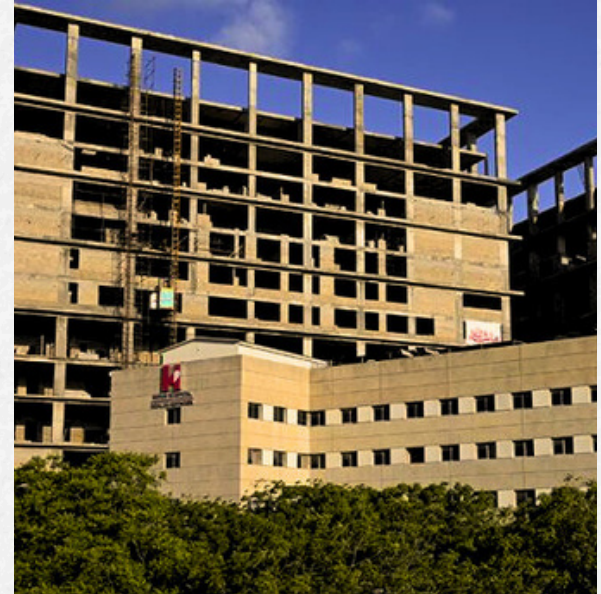
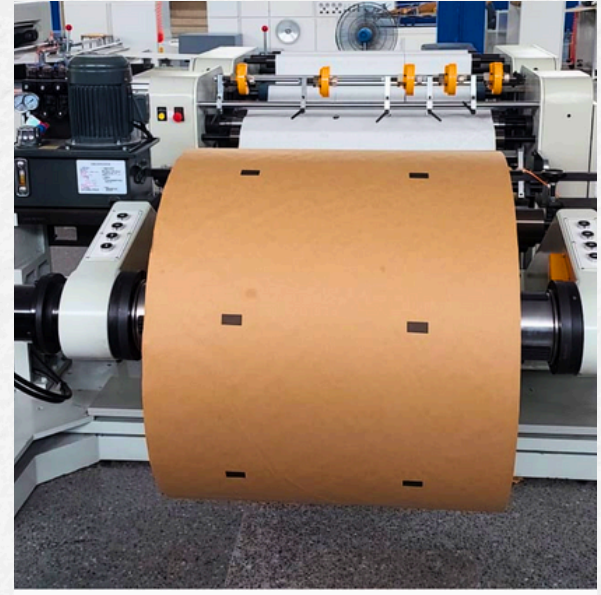

GFG: A DIVERSIFIED PORTFOLIO OF EXCELLENCE



GREAVES PAKISTAN (PVT) LTD



Greaves Pakistan Pvt. Ltd. marked a transformative year with major partnerships and projects across its divisions. In the Material Handling & Mining Division, the company secured distributorships with Hitachi and Metso, while supplying heavy-duty earth-moving equipment to a leading copper and gold project.



The Water Division broadened its scope by adding Cooling Towers and, in the renewable space, Greaves Solar commissioned landmark projects, including 5MW for Feroze1888, 2.5MW for Fatima Packaging, 2MW for Kamal Textiles, and 212kW for StarLabs. The division further strengthened its portfolio by becoming the authorized distributor of Gotion BESS.



Other divisions also posted strong achievements: a 3500 kVA Kohler powerhouse for NLC King Hamad Project in Islamabad and life-saving gensets for Indus Hospital Karachi; premium Elaflex hosepipe systems for oil and gas and overflow protection systems for Pakistan Railways; and OTIS elevators installed at Centaurus Mall, Center Point Building, and Emaar's The Views & Panorama.

GREAVES AIRCONDITIONING PVT LTD

Greaves Air Conditioning has two significant contract wins that highlight its continued growth and customer trust.

In April 2025, GAC secured a 3-year Service Level Agreement with the Pakistan Civil Aviation Authority for Islamabad International Airport, which will commence in September, 2025 and will cover HV/LV, HVAC, STP, Waterworks, and BTS. This marks a third successful renewal, showcasing the strength of their North and Head Office service teams.

GAC's Karachi Sales Team also won a contract for Indus Hospital Karachi – Phase 2 Extension, for the supplying and commissioning of 79 hygienic air handling units with Thermal Bridging Class 1. This is GAC's second project with Indus Hospital, reinforcing client confidence and long-term partnerships.

Notably, the project totals 3,600 tons and will be completed in a record 8 weeks at the state-of-the-art JCI Robotic Factory.

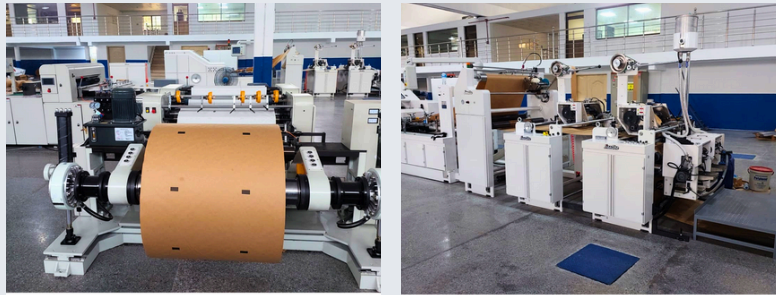
CHERAT PACKAGING LTD

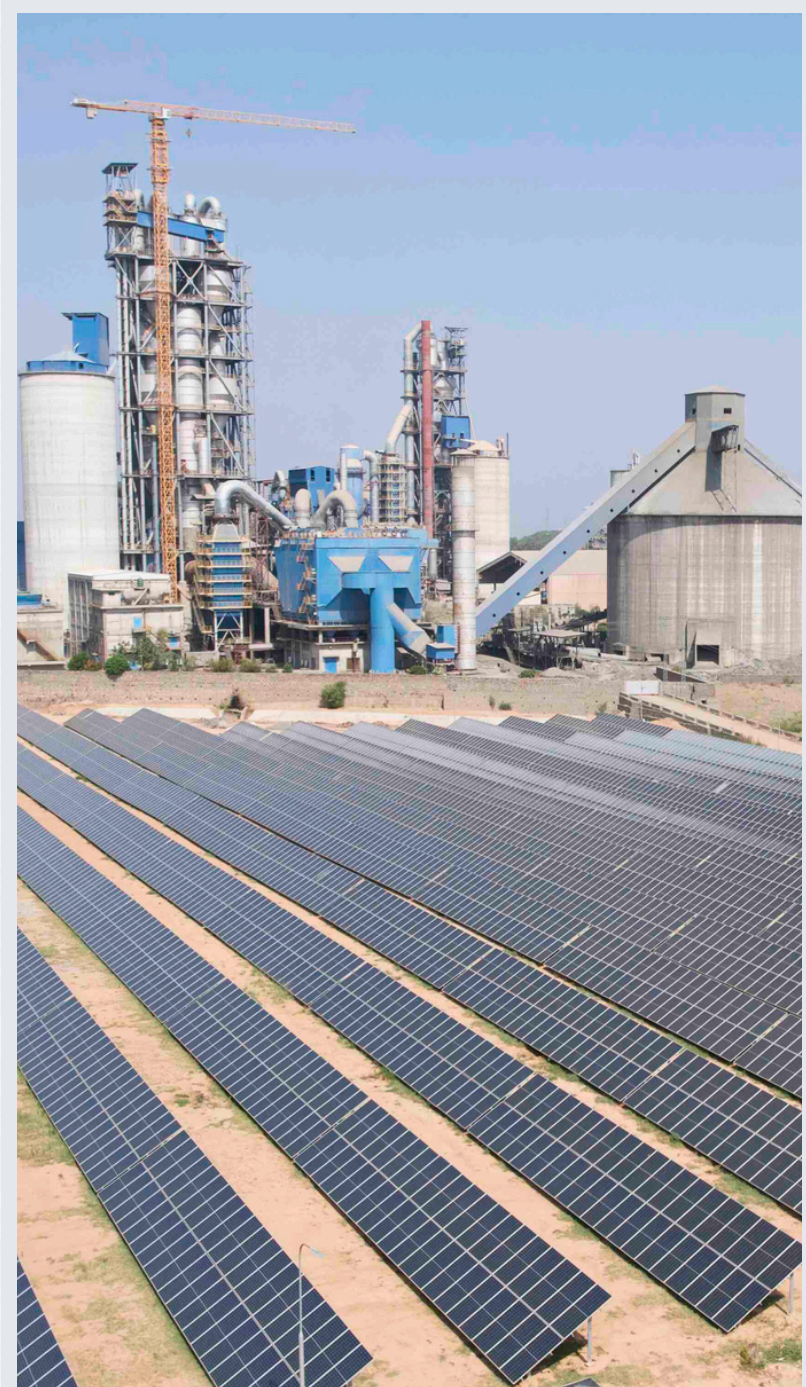


CHERAT CEMENT COMPANY LTD

With surplus liquidity in hand, Cherat Cement is pursuing strategic investments in Rafhan Maize and Attock Cement – two industry leaders. Following thorough due diligence and the successful NBO stage, binding offers have been submitted. These potential acquisitions align with CCCL's long-term diversification strategy and promise substantial value creation for the Group and its shareholders.

Furthermore, Cherat Cement expanded its renewable energy footprint by commissioning a 9MW solar power project at its Nowshera site, increasing CCCL's total solar capacity to 23MW. This marks another step toward reducing reliance on fossil fuels and promoting a greener future.

In June 2025, Cherat Cement partnered with LUMS to deliver a five-day Leadership Program, equipping their talent with essential skills in strategic thinking, communication, and change management through engaging, faculty-led sessions.





MIRPURKHAS SUGAR MILLS LTD

Mirpurkhas Sugar Mills' largest initiative this year—the Pulp Project—is well underway and set to transform its Paper & Board division.

With civil construction over halfway complete and installation targeted for October 2025, this project is expected to reduce raw material costs by up to 20%. It aligns with MSM's strategic vision of lowering import dependency and enhancing in-house capability.

In August 2025, MSM proudly celebrated Independence Day with heartfelt enthusiasm alongside all GFG companies. From flag-hoisting ceremonies and themed decor to team-building activities, the celebrations were a vibrant expression of unity, patriotism, and shared values.

On the cybersecurity front, end-of-life FortiGate firewalls were replaced with high-performance models at MSM and CPL Flexi Unit. This upgrade—executed entirely by Zensoft's in-house IT teams—doubles throughput, enhances threat protection, and restores full UTM services.
